

Change to Junior School Stationery Requirements (2026)

Dear Parents and Carers.

I am writing to inform you of a change to Junior School stationery requirements beginning in 2026. From 2026 onwards, the school will purchase all stationery required for students' classroom use throughout the year. This includes:

- Exercise and writing books
- Textbooks for class programs
- Writing utensils such as pens, pencils, markers, and highlighters

Student diaries will continue to be supplied for all year levels. Kindergarten – Year 2 students will also receive a mesh, zippered pouch for storing their early learning materials.

By centralising the purchase of these materials, we aim to ensure that every student has access to the same resources, and to reduce the need for families to source specific items ahead of the school year. Stationery supplies will be distributed by teachers as required and replenished during the year.

Families are encouraged to continue providing a few personal items for their child:

- Pencil case
- Art smock or paint shirt
- Library bag
- Headphones (with AUX cable)

Students may also bring their own preferred textas or coloured pencils if they wish, though this is entirely optional.

Please note that **students in Stage 3 (Years 5 and 6)** are required to bring a **laptop device** to school each day as part of their learning program. Information about device specifications will be communicated with Stage 3 parents separately.

We believe this change will make the start of each school year simpler for families and more consistent for students across the Junior School. Thank you for your support as we implement this improvement for 2026.
