WHAT

Students from Years 5-12 are expected to have a device that meets the minimum standards outlined below.

General Minimum Requirements for All Devices:

- Screen size: 11 inch
- Screen resolution: 1024 x 768
- Wireless Connectivity: 802.11G or N
- Audio/Video: Headphone and Microphone Ports
- No 3G/4G embedded support
- Full QWERTY Keyboard suitable for touch-typing
- Minimum expected battery life of 6 hours
- Robust carry case
