Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs): P&F Clothing Pool (CP)

Does MAGS have a Clothing Pool?

Yes. The MAGS pre-loved School Uniform Clothing Pool (Clothing Pool) is operated by the Macquarie Anglican Grammar School Parents' and Friends' Association (Macquarie P&F).

What is the Clothing Pool?

The Clothing Pool sells pre-loved MAGS school uniforms donated by other MAGS families to be resold at a discounted price. The money raised goes to Macquarie P&F to be spent on projects and items that enhance the educational experience of the MAGS students.

Where is the Clothing Pool shop?

Behind the Alinta Uniform shop is a 40-foot shipping container converted into a shop.

When is the Clothing Pool open?

The Clothing Pool is currently open each term:

- 1st week Friday (2:30 - 4:30 pm)
- 2nd last week Friday (2:30 - 4:30 pm)
- 1st Wednesday of the month (8:15 - 9:00 am)
- Week 5 lunchtime (12:00 - 2:00 pm)

What uniform items are stocked at the Clothing Pool?

Any new logo uniforms that are donated to Macquarie P&F become the stock available for purchase each term.

How much do you charge for Clothing Pool items?

The Clothing Pool sells items at 40% of the current 'new RRP' or for any new items, 50% of the RRP.

Can I get a discount if an item is stained or damaged?

No, all items are sold 'as seen', with CP volunteers monitoring the quality of stock, so some items will already be on the bargain \$5 rack.

Can I ask for an item to be placed 'on hold' for me?

No, we operate on a first-come, first-served basis when the Clothing Pool is open.

How can I pay for items at the Clothing Pool?

Macquarie P&F does not accept cash payments. We have an EFTPOS machine, and welcome credit and debit cards (no American Express). A receipt will be emailed or texted to you immediately upon payment.

Can I return or exchange items?

We do not accept returns or exchanges. Please carefully consider your purchase.

I can't make it to the Clothing Pool when it is open – what are my options?

Ask a friend, family member or student to attend the Clothing Pool on your behalf. Alternatively, you can look for or put up a wanted post for your required items on the Macquarie P&F FACEBAY page, or Facebook Marketplace.

Macquarie P&F has a big blue clothing bin, located outside the front of the Trade Centre. This is near the P2 drop-off/pick-up location.
